**PASSING OF SISTER MARCY L. BUNNELL**

By the authority vested in me as President of the Department of California and Pacific it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1: It is my sad duty to report the unexpected passing of Sister Marcy L. Bunnell on December 7, 2008 in Paradise, California, at the age at 53 years.

Section 2: Marcy was a Charter Member of both the Dr. Mary E. Walker Auxiliary No. 52 of San José, California and the newly-formed Ivy Stiers Auxiliary No. 23 of Santa Rosa, California. She was a current Trustee of the Department of California and Pacific and of Auxiliary No. 52. She had also served the Auxiliary at various times as Vice-President, Chaplain, and Patriotic Instructor.
