PAST CAMP COMMANDER PRIVILEGES

By the authority vested in me as Commander of the Gen. Alfred Pleasonton Camp No. 24, by the Camp Bylaws, Department of California and Pacific Bylaws, the National Constitution and Regulations, and National Policies, it is hereby ordered as follows:
