VETERANS DAY 2015

By the authority vested in me as Commander of General William Passmore Carlin Camp 25, Department of California and Pacific, by the Camp Bylaws, the Department Bylaws, the National Constitution and Regulations, and National Policies, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Veterans Day, November 11, 2015: All Camp members shall demonstrate Honor and Respect for all Veterans who dedicated themselves to the preservation of principles set forth by the United States of America on Veterans Day by flying the Flag of the United States of America and taking a few moments to pray for those service men and women who sacrificed their lives to that cause and their loved ones who grieve that loss. It should also be noted that while this sacred day was formerly known as Armistice Day marking the end of World War I, it was changed to Veterans Day on June 1, 1954, to be inclusive of the World War II and Korean War veterans (a dwindling number of old Spanish-American War and a couple of Civil War veterans were also still around).
