#### PASSING OF BROTHER RICHARD "LARRY" COMSTOCK

By the authority vested in me as Commander of the Phil Sheridan Camp No. 4, by the Camp Bylaws, Department of California and Pacific Bylaws, the National Constitution and Regulations, and National Policies, it is hereby ordered as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: It is my sad duty to report the passing of Camp Brother Richard L. "Larry" Comstock on October 17, 2011. He was 79 years old.

<u>Section 2</u>: Larry faithfully served the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War as an active member of the Camp as the Eagle Scout Certificate Coordinator. He received his membership through Private Orlando Hastings of Company F, 25th Wisconsin Volunteer Infantry Regiment.

<u>Section 3</u>: Brother Comstock served as President of the South Bay Civil War Round Table for two years and also as the Program Director. He had a thirty year interest in the Civil War and was related to Bvt. Brig. Gen. Cyrus B. Comstock, who was Aide-de-Camp to Lt. Gen. U. S. Grant. Larry held a Ph.D. degree in Electrical Engineering from Stanford and retired in 1990 from IBM where he managed departments involved in disk drive development. He spent fifteen years teaching in the Department of Materials Science at San José State University and after retirement enjoyed traveling, especially to Civil War battlefields, and sailing in Santa Cruz. He is survived by his wife Marilyn, two children and four grandchildren.

<u>Section 4</u>: Brother Comstock's loss will be deeply felt throughout the Camp. Therefore, the Camp Charter shall be draped in black and all Camp Brothers are respectfully directed to attach a black mourning ribbon to their membership badge (pursuant to C&R, Article III, Sec. 9) for a period of thirty (30) days.

Section 5: Phil Sheridan Camp No. 4 extends its sincere condolences to the Comstock family, as well as all of his many friends.
