Frederick L Thayer Diary Donated

I knew that my namesake great grandfather, Frederick L Thayer, on my mother's side, had kept a diary during his Union Infantry tour of duty in 1862, Co C, 22nd Mass Regt Vols. It came to be that my older brother had it. After finally retrieving the diary, my family decided to dedicate it to the GAR Museum in Aurora Illinois, where he had been Camp Commander in 1891. The plan was to drive to Aurora on a 'road-trip' to dedicate it. Plans changed. All travel was cancelled. I did arrange to send the diary to a camp commander in Aurora who made the dedication in our name. This is a photo of a SUVCW member dedication it to the GAR Museum. It is unique as that it was handwritten in 1862, the original.

The diary was transcribed in 2016, by my cousin and is available in paperback through Pelican Press, enter; Frederick L Thayer, War of the Rebellion.

Frederick Thayer is buried in Aurora and every Memorial and Veterans Day I have a bouquet of red-white-blue flowers placed on his grave.
