MINUTES OF CAMP MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 21, 2016

Meeting was called to order by Commander Charles Kenyon at 7:05 pm

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved

Treasurer's Report: Brother Johnson reported that as of May 31st, the camp has \$674.08, \$200 of which is in the Braden Schall Memorial Fund

Gary Hormel submitted his application papers to the camp. Gary's second great-grandfather, William Timmerman, was a private in Company B of the Ohio 170th infantry. He was mustered in on May 13th, 1864 and served 5 months. Gary's membership was unanimously accepted, and Commander Kenyon presented him with a membership medallion. Gary mentioned that he has visited practically every Civil War site on the East Coast, and was particularly moved by the National Park at Fredericksburg.

It was moved and seconded that the camp purchase the following from the SUVCW Quartermaster: 10 Eagle Scout certificates; 10 JROTC certificates & medals; 10 membership certificates; and 10 Camp Officer certificates. The camp secretary/treasurer will see to this.

Brother Felton reminded the members that Saturday, October 15th, is clean-up day at the Alhambra Cemetery in Martinez, where several Union soldiers are buried. The clean-up is from 10 am to 2 pm.

Also on October 15th is the Fort Mervin Civil War Day in Monterey, sponsored by the SUVCW.

On November 11th, the San Jose Veteran's Day Parade will be held, starting at The Plaza de Cesar Chavez at 11 am. Any members interested in attending should contact the San Jose camp.

The next camp meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 19, 7 p.m., at the California Genealogical Society Office in Oakland.
