# Collection Title: Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, Department of California & Pacific, General William Starke Rosecrans Camp Number 2

**Description**: This collection includes a variety of items including 1) The Historians Book binder, 2) copies of the "The Banner," the National Organization's journal as well as 3) a few copies of the bi-monthly local Camp newsletters entitled "The Rosecrans Report," which was selected for the "John G. Nicolay Best Camp Newsletter Award" in 2000 due to its use of color and overall professionalism.

**Background**: The Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War is a patriotic and educational organization, similar to the Grand Army of the Republic. It was founded on November 12, 1881 and incorporated by Act of Congress August 20, 1954.

The Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War is the legal heir to and representative of the Grand Army of the Republic. The Gen. W. S. Rosecrans Camp No. 2 of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War was named after an original Sons' Camp which was organized March 3, 1898, and which in turn was named for <u>General William Starke</u> <u>Rosecrans (1819-1898)</u>. When the camp became inactive is unclear.

The current Camp was organized and reactivated on August 21, 1999 under Camp Commander Linn P. Hoadley and in 2021, Ken Walker is the only current Camp member to have signed the charter. The Rosecrans camp co-hosted the <u>131st Annual</u> <u>Encampment 10-12 August 2012</u>.

Much of the Camp's property and archives, such as a Family Bible. Given by the Rosecrans Family and rebound by Kater-Crafts Bookbinders, had been in storage at Patriot Hall but returned to the Camp by PDC Glen Roosevelt in March 2007 and in January 2012 given to Phil Gaines. The Camp Commander has the Bible, Camp gavel, the alter cloth, and some small banners. Nick Smith is in possession of a wooden box for voting on prospective members using white and black balls. The Camp Drum is unlocated? No other known property in early 2021.

The extant archives were transferred by Camp Commander Dean Smith to Camp Historian, Dr. John Richardson on 11 February 2021.
